- 1 The 6th Pittaluga JUNIOR is open to soloists of all nationalities. Age limit: those under 16 years of age on the date of September 30th 2022. The Pittaluga Junior requirements: free choice program of 8/10 minutes' length.
- 2 The competition will run in mixed form, with a first selection online and a second round in-person audition.
- 3 The international Jury will consist of a minimum of five members of different nationalities with an established reputation in the music world. The judgments of the Jury will take into account the quality and the difficulty of the works played and, in case of transcriptions, the quality of the selected transcriptions
- 4 The competitors who intend to participate in the Pittaluga JR must send their application latest on 10th August 2022 writing their programme. The registration to the competition will be completed by sending the video uploaded online on youtube with the title: Alessandria 6 Pittaluga JR 2022+full name of the candidate. The link to the video must be received by 10 September 2022, and must be sent by email to: concorso@pittaluga.org
- 5 The video-recording must have these specifications: Full HD, 1920 x 1080 px, preferably in Mp4. The competitors must visibly place the poster of the 6th Pittaluga Junior that will be sent to the registered competitors. In the video the candidate must be seen during the entire duration of the pieces performed, without video editing nor zooming, in a frontal position and the video camera near so the face, hands and the guitar are clear on the screen.
- 6 On 12th September the panel of Jury in online session will choose the three best performers who will be invited to perform the same recorded programme in presence on Saturday 1 October 2022. From this round the jury will choose the First Prize by assigning reimbursements and other prizes to the finalists. The Final round will be held on 1 October 2022 at the Pittaluga Auditorium of the Vivaldi Conservatory in Via Parma 1 Alessandria in the presence of the convened Jury.
